




Methodology: The Bloomberg Consumer Comfort Index is produced by <u>Langer Research</u> <u>Associates</u>. The index is reported in a four-week rolling average; this week's results are based on a random national sample of 1,000 adults, reached by landline and cellular telephone, in the four weeks ending April 20, 2014. The results have a 3-point error margin. Field work and tabulation by SSRS/Social Science Research Solutions of Media, Pa.

The index is derived by subtracting the negative response to each index question from the positive response to that question. The three resulting numbers are added and divided by three. The index can range from +100 (everyone positive on all three measures) to -100 (all negative on all three measures). The survey began in December 1985.
